Of June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022

The Greenview Village Board met for a regular scheduled board meeting on Monday June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The roll call indicated that Trustees Patrick Feagans, Brandon Wellhausen, Elizabeth Soldwedel and Norman Hofmann were present. ### **Public Participation:**

John Holt gave the treasurer report. A motion was made by Trustee Wellhausen and seconded by Trustee Hofmann to accept the treasurer report. All present in favor voted aye. Report filed into record.

**Trustee Wellhausen:** Received packets for insurance renewals. And police health insurance was approved. Discussion was had on purchasing flags for flag poles. A motion was made by Trustee Hofmann and seconded by Trustee Feagans to purchase flags up to \$500. Motion was roll called, all in favor voted aye. Motion passed.
