

Greenview Village Board Minutes of September 18, 2023

The Greenview Village Board met for a regularly scheduled Board meeting on Monday, September 18, 2023. President Kevin Curry called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM and all present participated in the Pledge of Allegiance. The roll call indicated that Trustees: Pam Rouse, Taya Smith, Liz Soldwedel, Norm Hofmann, Pat Feagans, Jamie Booth were present. Other Village personnel present was John Holt. John Holt delivered the Treasurer's Report, with a motion to approve made by Trustee Feagans, seconded by Trustee Smith. All present voted aye. Motion carried. Report filed into record.
